Peter and Miriam Fretheim have served in Nigeria for over 20 years, and they will serve anyone. This matters because Nigeria is a country unfortunately known for fighting and murder between different religions and ethnic groups. But their City Ministries team works to break down these barriers through love. Together with BRC, they repaired a broken well at a local prison to provide clean water, and many inmates became open to the gospel for the first time.

Chikondi

An American couple who decided to say “yes” to Jesus unexpectedly saw an opportunity to reach kids around the world with the gospel - through puppet shows. Starting in English and French, their kids’ show called “Chikondi” has now expanded into the entire Muslim world because it has been picked up by satellite TV. An adorable show that teaches children about Kingdom values is now being broadcast all over Sub-Saharan Africa and beyond.

In Nigeria, cows can be a fantastic way to people’s hearts. The City Ministries team helped to vaccinate the cows of the Fulani herdsmen, who depend on cows for their livelihood and just love their cows so much! This was a radical step because the mainly Muslim Fulani have long been hostile to the area’s Christians, until the cow vaccinations started. When the state governor asked why there was suddenly peace, the most radical of the Muslim leaders replied it was because of the ministry of vaccinating Fulani cattle! The government even reached out to thank Peter and his team, demonstrating that these outreaches are being used by God in powerful ways that they never even expected. They chose to meet a need of people who weren’t even friendly, and it is bringing noticeable peace to a region that desperately needs it!
